Recently Kail has produced 2023 USEF Intermediate National Single Horse champion Sunrise’s Commander and Ryley Miller, 2024 USEF Reserve VSE Training National Champion McDreamy and Mary Baldwin, and 2024 USEF Bronze Medal Training Single Horse Windfall’s First and Mary Baldwin. As well as currently producing her daughter at the FEI 3-star level.
